



Summary of known Implementations of DDEX Standards

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1 Introduction

DDEX has, over the last couple of years, created a rich set of standards that streamline the exchange of metadata along the media delivery chain. Such standards increase their value by the number of users: the more users there are, the higher is the likelihood that a new business partner also uses the standard.

DDEX is collating information from its approx. 70 members and approx. 650 companies that have taken out an implementation licence regarding the use of its standards with a view of making this some of this information, essentially who has implemented what and with whom, available on its website.

This document contains the information received by DDEX thus far; we expect this list to be updated regularly. Some 25 companies have responded but *not given DDEX the permission to publish their name* within this document; their privacy has thus been protected.

This document does not list those companies who use a third party aggregator to exchange DDEX messages with their business partners. Instead only the aggregator is being listed.

Finally, this document is limited to message exchange and choreography standards. It thus does not list supporting standards such as the Automated Message Exchange Standard, the Data Dictionary Standard or the DDEX Party Identifier Standard that anyone using any message exchange standard has to use.
